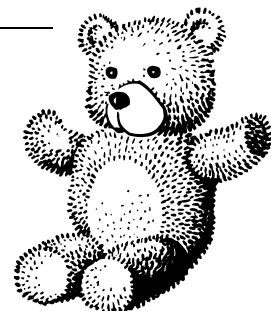

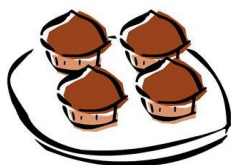
If you have any soft toys, new or used, that we can have for the toy tombola at the fayre we would be pleased to receive them!
