Curriculum Statement of Intent PSHE (including RHE and SEd)

At Woolston Infant School a PSHE (Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education) curriculum aims to provide our pupils with spiritual, moral, cultural, mental and physical development and to prepare them for the opportunities, responsibilities and experiences of life.

Our PSHE curriculum intends to enable our pupils to acquire and develop the knowledge, skills and vocabulary they need to live a healthy, safe, responsible and balanced life.

Woolston Infant School PSHE supports our Spiritual, Moral, Social and Cultural learning (SMSC) and encompasses British Values. It strengthens our caring and inclusive ethos as well as our School Values of Achievement, Cooperation, Kindness, Perseverance and Tolerance.
