

Starting in September 2024

- Your child will be in one of the two Reception Year classes, Willow or Cedar with 30 children in each class.
- Each class has a teacher and learning support assistant all day.
- School starts at 8.35am. The gates to the classrooms and the school site close at 8.50am.
- School finishes at 3.05pm. If a different person will be collecting your child please complete a 'red' permission slip.
- Attendance is vital and your child is expected to be in school everyday. If your child is unwell you must ring the school office by 9.20am.

School uniform

School uniform must be worn everyday.

Boys: It consists of a red sweatshirt, white polo/shirt and black/grey trousers.

Girls: Can wear dress, skirts or trouser in black/grey, with a white shirt/polo.

Black school shoes

- Sweatshirts/cardigans and polo shirts with the school logo can be ordered online via scopay. It is fine to have a plain polo t-shirt or sweatshirt/cardigan without the logo.
- PE Kit consists of red t-shirt, red shorts and plimsolls.
- Book bags are essential to carry books, letters and work home.
 We will provide one when your child starts school.
- Water bottles will be provided and must be in school every day containing water. 1st bottle will be provided by the school.

Dress and undress




Put on their shoes and socks
